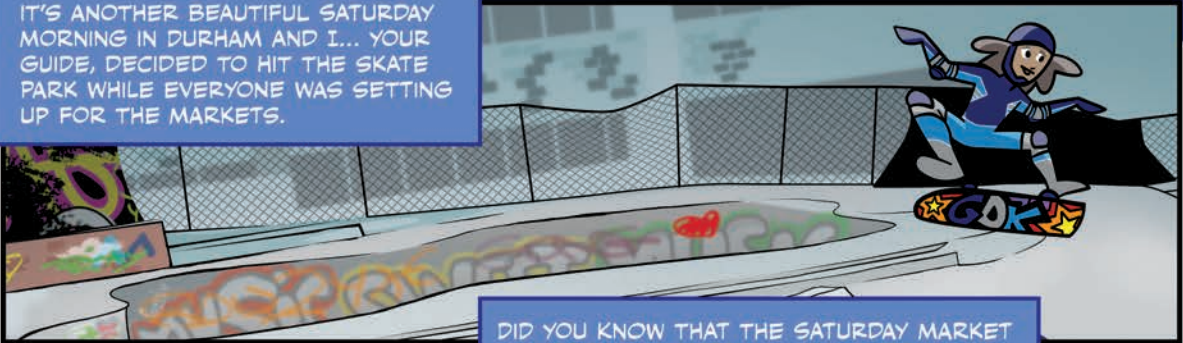






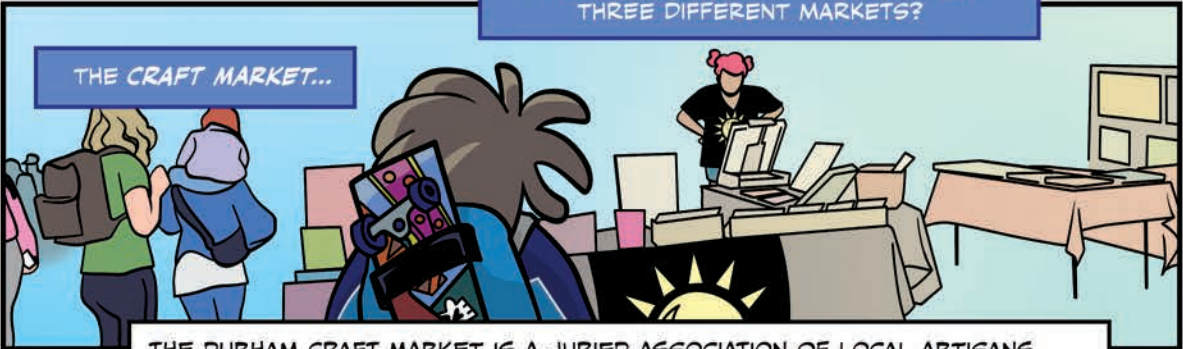
# THERE'S NO MYSTERY GDK CAN'T SOLVE
