GoDurham strictly prohibits smoking at Durham Station.

The Durham Station Transportation Center is a smoke-free facility, in accordance with the City of Durham's ordinance prohibiting smoking and vaping in public buildings and grounds. This includes all indoor and outdoor areas of the station, such as the platforms and concourses.

This is being done to protect the health of our non-smoking riders, employees as well as our environment. To avoid such adverse circumstances, no rider or employee should be found smoking or vaping anywhere on the immediate premises.

Per the Durham County Regulation of Smoking in Prescribed Public Areas (adopted by the Durham County Board of Commissioners in 2017), smoking is prohibited at Durham Station.

Smoking is defined as:

Smoking – The use of a vaping device, e-cigarette, lighted cigarette, lighted cigar, lighted pipe, or any other lighted tobacco product.

Effective, Monday April 7, 2025, all smoking will be banned from the Durham Station Transportation Center. This means smoking is completely prohibited and action will be taken to ensure the ban is strictly followed.
