Meeting Opens: 5:30 PM

➤ **Doug Middleton, General Manager of GoDurham**

- Middleton welcomed and thanked all attendees for coming to the second Public Meeting of 2025, as spring is blooming, and temperatures rise.
- GoDurham's hiring efforts are ongoing and remain a focus for the company as growth is imperative to continue providing service as the next service change is upcoming in the summer of 2025.
- Effective April 7th, 2025, GoDurham will no longer allow smoking of any kind, including tobacco products, vapes, or other related products, on the Durham Station Premises.
- Starting April 7th, GoDurham representatives and the Durham Police Department will be present for a couple of weeks at Durham Station to remind riders that smoking is strictly prohibited and must be done elsewhere.
- This strict smoking ban has been implemented to prioritize the health of individuals in a public area and reduce the amount of litter present.
