In accordance with the requirements of 49 CFR Part 26, this letter and the attached documents shall serve as notification of GoDurham (formerly Durham Area Transit Authority) Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) goal for the federal fiscal years 2017-2019 (October 1, 2016— September 30, 2018). GoDurham has established a proposed DBE goal as 8%, to be attained through race-neutral methods.

GoDurham approved the goal of 8% on June 1, 2016. DATA published the proposed DBE goal for FFY 2017-2019 beginning on June 13, in *Passenger Transport, the Magazine, the Durham HeraldSun Newspaprer* and will also be included in all proposal advertising involving GoDurham's projects. Documentation for the goal was available for review through June 29, 2016, and public comments were accepted on the goal through that date. However no public comments were received.

The attached documents include: an overview of the methodology used to establish the goal and a summary of the data used in the calculations, a copy of the notice to the public regarding the publication of our goal, and letters to surrounding business's and DBE supporters. DATA's staff developed the goal consistent with the requirements of 49 CFR 26.45.

GoDurham (Formerly Durham Area Transit Authority) DBE GOAL FYY 2017-2019 METHODOLOGY

Step 1: Determine the value of federally assisted contracts for FY 16

- Reviewed approved GoDurham budget line items and discussed projected contracting values with Project and Department Managers, Administration and DBE Director.
- Identified \$2,054,531.10 as total value of expected federally assisted contracts in FY2016. We do
 not currently have information for FY17 and FY18 but anticipate similar contracting
 opportunities for those years. Therefore, our goal for FY 17 of 8% will also stand for FY 18 and
 FY 19.

Step 2 : Calculate Base Number of DBE Firms

- Reviewed DBE directory, found through the NDCOTDBE Vendor List (Connect NCDOT.gov/business/vendordirectory).
- Found 1,017 total DBE firms in North Carolina in the State of North Carolina and, removed listings that do not correspond to contracting opportunities, as well as listings not in division 5 (Durham county's division)

The total weighted base figure for DBE availability is 8.1%.

ADJUSTMENT TO BASE FIGURE

As specified in the federal regulations codified in 49 CFR Section 26.45 once the relative availability of ready willing and able DBE's in our marketplace has been determined, it was necessary to examine additional evidence and if appropriate make adjustments to the base to ensure that the goal accurately reflects the level of DBE participation we would expect absent the effects of discrimination.

There is no evidence to suggest that there is a lessened nor increased capacity of DBEs to
perform work, nor has there any disparity studies done in our area that would have any bearing
on our goal. Consequently, GoDurham has decided not to adjust its base figure upward and
believe the 8% figure would be a good representation of our targeted DBE goal for the next
three years.

RACE-NEUTRAL VS RACE -CONSCIOUS

Based on our analysis above we believe that contracting opportunities for the next three years would be very similar to the last the experience of the last few years. Therefore our goal is appropriate and attainable through race-neutral method.

GoDUrham intends to make contracting opportunities attractive to DBE;s by offering technical assistance in completing bids, marketing bid opportunities to DBE's making RFPs more attractive, simplifying bonding and insurance requirements and distributing DBE directories to prime contractors.






